Angels in Outfield - Steve Oberg - Food drive in Feb to benefit Valley View Center. 13K from Toy drive raised and donated to 5 orgs. Remaining with SC West still unresolved.

American League - All in order after draft - 5 teams - interest in obtaining permission from CL players to sub in AL - will contact CL chair.

CL League - Tim Heenan - successful draft - 5 teams with 6 subs - one returned to NL - Larry Chapman reported on effort to have Friday afternoon pickup games with SC West players who will be required to sign waivers and pay a minimal amount to play. **Motion to approve** waiver requirement - motion by Heenan 2nd by Dickerson

National League - Mary Toland - will have 6 teams - using AL & CL pitchers and umpires.

Co-ed League - Pauline Robinson - we only played 5 games due to rain, tournaments, etc. In future we would like Saturdays kept open from Jan to April - we have 21 women but need to recruit more - we now have a Co-ed committee.

Golf Tournament - Jim Sundberg - March 17 at South Course, dinner following at Fairway. Need volunteers - Mary Dellopoulos requested all managers to plead with their players to have volunteers to sponsor a hole, assist with sign-ups at the course, sell mulligans, help with gimmick holes, etc

Hall of Fame - Dan Braddock, Dennis Robins, Tom Dellopoulos - selected Jim Alexander, Dennis Johnson, Chuck Witterich. Banquets at Palm Ridge Rec Ctr in SC West March 4 at 5 PM. Mary Toland to provide tickets to managers to sell. In the future SC will have to develop its own rules for the HOF.

Green Team - Rickie Toland - have added 4 new players recently - transition to Mark Merkley as the new Green Team manager underway.

Field Report - Roger Beckes - trying to set up a time for Clay from Stabilizer Solutions to remove the "coffee grounds", laser level the field, direct the drainage away from the parking and toward the area behind right field - will take 5 days and may have to interrupt a week in the season. Water pressure will be increased to 150 psi. SC members are allowed to bid on work if they are licensed contractors and have liability insurance.

New - Shirts - Tom Reynolds advocated for allowing shirts to be untucked - after brief

discussion of pros and cons, Paul Dickerson moved, seconded by Rickie Toland to have a vote at the General Membership Meeting in March to decide the issue **Approved**

Donations for Clubhouse - Steve Oberg urged managers and players NOT to accept gifts until a master plan has been developed - suggestions were made for having champion team plaques and/or HOF inductees.

New Suggestions - (1) Mark Kisala offered that we should have at least one tournament per session to showcase our new field by inviting out of town teams (2) Discussion about sending to winning team sponsors a framed picture of their team as a thank you - no volunteers! (3) Steve Oberg asked for suggestions for a time capsule for the new park (4) Jim Smith suggested we take out for a full year block ad informing readers of the existence of our park and seeking players

January Month-End Financials Report Approved

Angels in the Outfield – Full report presented by Donna

1. Ministered to 5 families during the last month.
2. Continued to work with SCW to develop AO for both communities
3. March 25 – “Golden Oldies Game and The Memorial” at Liberty Field (3-6 PM) for both communities.

American League – Discussion on suggesting new style of ball pants. Once the IN/OUT jersey style is decided, we may consider the new uniform pants.

Central League – Pickup games involving Green Team members have been very successful and needed.

National League – Dedicated practice times for National League has resulted in improved batting averages over the full league.

Co-Ed League – Overall working OK, however there is still a great need for more women players. Concern that American League players pose a possible danger due to the skill gap versus other players. Due to this “Gap” some players have shied away from the Co-Ed play.

Golf Tournament – As normal, registrations are coming in slow, but no big worries at this time. No handicaps will be used in scoring. Rankings of the foursomes will be scored in “flights” only.

Park Remodel – Construction basically on schedule. Batting cage supporting poles are up as if Feb 13; The profile behind the “crow’s nest” will be a relatively flat roof due to ADA requirement for an elevator if building a second story addition. Discussion was heard about the new sound system that will be needed at the park.

RCSC will have a grand opening for the new buildings once construction is complete.

SC Softball Club will have their own grand opening celebration nearer to the start of the Fall Session so more of our own players can participate. Discussion on a tentative date of October 19th, 2024 or that whole weekend may be encompassed for our Club’s Grand Opening Celebration.

Next week – Feb 19-23, the DW Memorial Field will be unavailable due to the enhancement of the infield area which will allow better drainage and better playable conditions.

Hall of Fame Banquet – March 4, 2024 being held the Palm Ridge Rec Center in SCW at 5:00 PM.

Banners – Looking for new sponsors and discussion was made concerning refreshing some banners due to wear and tear over time.

Uniforms – Discussions made on summer uniforms. Possibly using the existing Sun City T-shirts with a number on the back of the jersey.

The membership vote on whether or not to allow the optional “Tuck/No Tuck” in regard to how players wear their jerseys will be held during the March 11, 2024 membership meeting. In order to get a sense of optics of this potential change, the time frame of Feb 26th – Mar 8th has been designated to be optional for either style.

Marketing Expo – Report given on the Marketing Expo. Suggestions given on improving the Club’s visibility and effectiveness in this outreach event.

Co-ed League - Pauline Robinson - we've had several games with West, Grand, Festival - we need help in setting up field on Saturday mornings - showed off new uniforms - still working on recruiting more women - signup for co-ed in next session.

Golf Tournament - Jim Sundberg - we have 28 foursomes, expecting several more - fewer dinner reservations than before - need big sponsor as Arvid Peterson won't donate as much as before - may be able to get better rates if we play in the afternoon

Park Remodel - Ron Coppess - we have been getting weekly and bi-weekly reports and we are close to the original schedule (best guess is completion by 1st week in June) - doors hung, electrical trench dug, drywall hung, plumbing and electrical roughed in, windows in 2 weeks, bldg. will be stained olive green with upstairs tan. **Batting Cage** - will be coin operated with options to select # of balls for each batter, floor to be carpeted, bin holds 250 balls, storage for Iron Mike.

Infield - Roger Beckes - positive report from all, stay off sodded grass - field is nail dragged on Wednesday, heavily watered on Tuesday, and drag instructions have been communicated to each league.

Shirt proposal - 69 members voted on the tucked shirt proposal - result was 37 for tucked shirts, 32 for player choice.

Softball Club Field expenses - added expenses for park remodel to be picked by by the Club include the PA and speaker system, additional plumbing and electrical work. Items for the clubhouse (fridge, chairs tables etc), cost of summer softball shirts, turf for batting cage. - Total cost \$39,112.60 - approved unanimously by all present.

Greg Griffith to make a proposal for a media room to watch games, etc. Upstairs Room - 3 chairs purchased - delayed decision on copier, computer, printer. Kitchen - Ice Maker & Microwave to be purchased.

Clubhouse Key List - To be determined after discussion with RCSC.

Player Participation Discussion - Ideas exchanged on how to ensure that all players who are registered and have paid their dues are placed on a team.
